Topics include: dialectic therapy, suicidal behavior, self-mutilation, brain research, medication, genetics, ADHD, executive functions, boundaries, borderline rage, manipulation, space mountain, removing the family, staying out of hospital, teeter totter, theory of oppositionality, and much more....
